



## **2017 WINTER SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE – BOYS AND GIRLS** **(2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Terms)**

***Students are to be modestly, neatly, meticulously and CORRECTLY dressed at all times – EVEN AND ESPECIALLY WHEN THEY ARE NOT ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS***

The current winter school uniform for girls and boys is listed below and must be **strictly adhered to** without exception, at all times. School uniform is compulsory.

**CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR: Samples are available at school. Please do not purchase incorrectly, as no exceptions are allowed.**

1. The official school golf shirt in the correct size for boys and girls. (Bras for the older girls are compulsory). Shirt buttons must be closed.
  2. Shirts for girls in the winter terms must be tucked in when worn with a jersey or jacket. Grade R-3 girls shirts are to be tucked in at all times.
  3. Boys' shirts must be tucked in at all times.
  4. Boys may not wear shorts in the winter terms.
  5. Girls may not wear skirts in the winter terms.
  6. Only long black straight legged trousers in the school style, purchased in the school wear department may be worn, by girls and boys (all grades). They must have a waistband and a zip. No elasticized or pull on trousers. These trousers must be the correct size and length. No tight, low-rise, skinny or baggy styles are permitted for both boys and girls. Girls' trousers may not be tight especially around the waist, buttock and thigh areas. Trousers must be waist high.
  7. Boys must wear a plain, black, formal belt at all times. No white stitching or big buckle.
  8. Absolutely NO JEANS, no denim/chinos. No low rise pants, no leggings, jeggings, skinny cuts etc. may ever be worn. No tracksuit, ski pants or athletic pants and no pull on pants (boys and girls).
  9. **FOOTWEAR:** In the winter term:- **Girls and boys** must both wear plain, all black, lace up Bata Toughee-type school shoes – no chunky soles or white stitching. No other style of shoe is permissible. Plain black socks – no patterns or symbols/logos or coloured heels or toes.
  10. **No t-shirts, spencers, vests, or any other undergarments may ever be visible ( no exceptions).**
  11. Beanies are only allowed to be worn on the school property, and only in extremely cold conditions and may not be worn in class. They must be plain black knitted beanies. Available from the school.
  12. Plain, black, knitted gloves and scarves. No tassles.
  13. Official school jersey and or Sleeveless pullover.
  14. Official school winter jacket. Hoods on jackets may not be worn unless it is raining.
- All clothing items are to be of a good quality and must be plain and unadorned.
  - Items of clothing must be clean and ironed at all times please.
  - Shoes must be cleaned and polished and shoe laces tied.
  - Please clearly mark all items of clothing with your child's name.



- For safety reasons, shoes must be worn at all times.

**HAIR CODE:** Hair must be clean, neatly brushed and cut and restrained at all times.

No weird/unorthodox or fashionable hairstyles are allowed.

Boys may only have conventional schoolboy haircuts.

No hair gels, waxes, sprays etc. are permitted.

Girls with long hair (on or past the shoulders) must have their hair completely tied up with plain black hairbands and clips. Hair may not be dyed/coloured during the school terms.

**NAILS:** Are to be kept clean and short (boys and girls). Girls may only wear clear nail varnish. No false nails, French tips or nail art is allowed.

**JEWELLERY:** No jewellery is allowed, except for a watch and a medic alert bracelet/necklace.

Only girls may wear small, solid all gold/all silver studs. Studs may not have stones of any kind. They may not be butterfly, flower, star etc. designs.

No nose, tongue, belly rings or any other visible body piercing, jewellery/rings etc. or visible tattoos.

- No make-up is allowed.

The only exception to any of the dress code requirements will be for medical reasons. Please notify the school and supply the appropriate medical certificate.

We trust that we can rely on both the parents and students' co-operation in adhering to the correct compulsory uniform dress code.

No non-compliant item/s may ever be worn without the schools' permission.

Students must be correctly dressed every day, without exception.

Please ensure you purchase sufficient uniform items and maintain them in good order, so that your child is able to wear a compliant uniform every day.

Please do not purchase non-compliant items as they will not be permitted.
